



Saint Lawrence Parish Brick Memorial

We are very excited to share with our Parish school family the newly designed **Saint Lawrence Parish Brick Memorial Garden and Walkway**. An **ideal spot** has been set aside overlooking the gently curving Means Brook at the western end of the parish grounds. The refurbished Blessed Mother statue will be moved from its original spot and situated at one end of a brick walkway while a peaceful resting and meditation area, surrounded by granite benches, will be placed at the other end. There will be plantings of small trees and shrubs as well as annual and perennial flowers, all designed to help create a beautiful and **sacred place of meditation**.

You will have the opportunity to purchase brick memorials to lovingly remember special family members, **special teachers, classmates**, friends, anniversaries, weddings and birthdates, to name only a few options. The bricks from the original brick memorial drive will be moved and included in the new design. Not only will you have the opportunity to donate a memorial brick, but there will be benches and plantings that can be donated in the name of a loved one. These memorials will be inscribed not only on the bricks, plantings or benches, but also in a special archive of the Parish.
